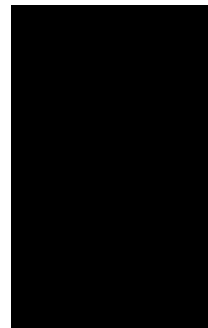
**SIGHTSPEED 6.0 NAMED ONE OF “100 BEST PRODUCTS OF 2007”
